6 Solid Reasons to Book the Same Meeting Host Year Over Year

There are several reasons why corporate meeting planners and event professionals may benefit by booking the same host/emcee over consecutive years. Here's the short list that supports the call back.

Success and Positive Feedback:

If a particular form of entertainment, such as a specific speaker, host/emcee, performer, or activity, has been wellreceived and successful in the past, event planners and professionals may be inclined to bring them back to ensure a positive and enjoyable experience for attendees.

Consistency in Branding: Using the same host/emcee can contribute to a consistent brand image for the company. They become associated with the corporate culture and values, creating a sense of continuity for







both employees and external stakeholders.

Reliability: Event professionals may opt for familiar hosting options because they know what to expect in terms of quality, audience engagement, and logistics. This reduces the risk of unexpected issues or disappointments during the event.

Limited Options: Depending on the nature of the corporate event, there might be a limited pool of suitable entertainment options that align with the event's theme, audience, and objectives. In such cases, event planners may stick with what has worked in the past.

Time Constraints: Planning and organizing a corporate event can be time-consuming, and event professionals may choose familiar hosts to save time and streamline the planning process.

Employee Preferences: If the host/emcee has consistently received positive feedback from employees, event professionals may prioritize their preferences to ensure better attendance and engagement.
